The Southwest Virginia Angus Association “More For Your Money Sale” 37th Annual Angus Sale was held 10/24/09 at the Southwest Bull Test Station Sale Facility in Wytheville, Va. There were sixty lots of registered Angus cattle that went through the sale ring to average \$1,585. The top selling cow/calf pair was consigned by Lyn Lew Farm Dublin, Virginia, the cow is a five year old daughter of Hyline Right Time 338 bred to calve 1/18/10 to the service of SAV Bismark 5682 and she sold for \$1,600 to Cool Breeze Farm in Abingdon, Virginia. Her 1/10/09 heifer calf sired by H S A F Bando 1961 sold for \$825 to Lawson Farm of Ewing, Virginia. Total of this pair was \$2,425. The second top selling pair was a consignment of Bayfield Farm, Chatham, Virginia, the cow is a three year old daughter of WAR Alliance 9126 6006 bred to calve 2/13/10 to Touchstone Bullseye 6626 and she sold for \$1,600 to Greg Southers of Princeton, West Virginia. Her heifer calf was born on 10/12/08 sired by BR Midland and she sold for \$800 to Bruce Porter of Rural Retreat, Virginia. Total of this pair was \$2,400. The third top selling cow/calf pair was consigned by Lyn Lew Farm Dublin, Virginia, the cow is a five year old daughter of G A R Exaltation 3144 bred to calve 1/19/10 to the service of Sitz Upward 307R and she sold for \$1,100 to Larry Linkous, Speedwell, Virginia. Her 2/3/09 bull calf sired by H S A F Bando 1961 sold for \$1,200 to Jerry Wright of Fries, Virginia. Total of this pair was \$2,300. The fourth top selling pair was a consignment of Justafew Angus, Max Meadows, Virginia, the cow is a four year old daughter of S A Neutron 377 bred to calve 1/15/10 to S S Objective T510 0T26 and she sold for \$1,400 to Larry Rhoton of Kingsport, Tennessee. Her bull calf was born on 1/18/09 sired by S S Objective T510 0T26 and sold for \$875 to Jerry Gentry of Mountain City. Total of this pair was \$2,275. We had 37 buyers from Virginia, North Carolina, Tennessee, and West Virginia. Volume buyers were Larry Linkous, Speedwell, Va., John Melvin of Bland, Va and David Moon of Climax, N.C.. Smith Reasor of Rural Retreat Va. was the Auctioneer and George T. Johnstone Jr. of Wytheville, Va. was the Sale Coordinator. The next sale for the Southwest Virginia Angus Association will be the December 12, 2009 “Southwest Virginia Angus Finest Sale” held at the Washington County Fairgrounds in Abingdon, Va.
